Eagle Project Reporting Procedure

1. Go to <http://www.goodturnforamerica.org>
2. Click on “**Tell Us About Your Service Project**”
3. Click on “**Report Your Unit's Service Hours**”
4. Login:
 - User Name** – xxxxxxxxxxx
 - Password** - xxxxxxxxxxx
5. Click where indicated next to: “**Would you like to report an Eagle Scout service project?**”
6. **Fill in the following:**
 - Applicant's Full Name
 - Member ID (from TroopMaster)
 - Eagle Project Completion Date
 - Project Title (limited to 60 characters)
 - Number of Scouts working on the project
 - Number of other youths working on the project
 - Number of Scout leaders working on the project
 - Number of other adults working on the project
 - Total number of hours spent by everyone working on the project
 - Total cost of materials required to complete the project
 - Which of the following categories best describes the Eagle Scout project?
 - Collecting books
 - Collecting clothing/shoes
 - Collecting school supplies
 - Collecting other items
 - Blood drive
 - Environmental/conservation
 - Building/construction
 - Education
 - Painting
 - Repairs
 - Landscaping/beautification
